While we support all governed State of Emergencies, we are also deeply saddened to hear about the cancelled events that go along with the declarations. Our members have put in so much work all year to showcase the Vietnamese culture and for it to be suspended or canceled by this novel virus is devastating.

It is important to understand that this outbreak is not to be taken lightly. Earlier this week, The World Health Organization (WHO) declared COVID-19 a pandemic as the virus sweeps into 114 countries. Growing number of cases and concerns have risen in our community and we ask you to take precaution. Take this time to be with your family, your loved ones, and people you care about. This outbreak is a never-before-seen event and our main priority is that our community is safe in these times.
